June 2 (Tue) 6:00pm	Dreamonita (Leong Fu Lai) Dream-interpreter	Dreamonita will perform a live dream-reading session with the artist, and discuss dream interpretation as a part of her professional practice.
June 19 (Fri) 4:00pm	Lawrence Pun Writer and poet	Lawrence will discuss dream and intoxication as metaphors in his writing, specifically his latest publication “the wandering collection”. He will also speak about references to dream in contemporary literature in general.
June 20 (Sat) 12:30pm	Linda Yim Concert pianist	Linda will discuss her relationship with Schumann's music in general. She will also perform a selection of Schumann's piano music on air.
June 21 (Sun) 10:30am	Wen Yau Artist / Researcher	Wen Yau will discuss the idea of dreaming and intoxication as related to her artistic practice.
July 4 (Sat) 10:30am	Jonathan Chui Certified clinical hypnotherapist	Jonathan will perform a “dream-work session” with the artist, and discuss dream work as a part of his professional practice. He will also discuss a couple of interesting cases he'd encountered in his professional career.
July 11 (Sat) 10:30am	Mak Su Yin Music theorist and Schumann specialist / Associate Professor, Department of Music, Chinese University of Hong Kong	Prof. Mak is an expert in the music of Schumann. In this interview she will discuss the composer's song cycle Dichterliebe (A Poet's Love).

July 11 (Sat) 12:30pm	Colleen Lee Concert pianist	Colleen will discuss her relationship with Schumann's music in general and also her Kinderszenen project in 2010. She will also perform a selection of Schumann's piano music on air.

10:00am – 2:30pm	Apollonian Morning Brew A series of interviews with musicians, artists, writers, academics and clinicians, on the topic of dream both as a physical phenomenon and a recurring metaphor in the arts
2:30pm – 4:30pm	The Ear of Dionysius at Midday A one-person radio drama, in which the artist repeatedly re-enacts a scene from the 1947 film Schumann's <i>Song of Love</i> .
4:30pm – 7:00pm	While the Daylight Lasts A twilight music program that features a selection of classical compositions that reference dream or dreaming, interspersed with the artist's commentaries.
